Getting Ready Photos

If you're getting ready at a different location to each other and you want getting ready photos of the bride AND groom prep you'll need a second photographer.

Couples Shots / Portraits

A second photographer can help with arranging your dress or capturing extra photos of you both or your guests at this time.

Wedding Group Photos

A second photographer makes these quicker by helping with correct posing, arranging the brides dress, taking care of handbags etc. They can also take additional candid photos.

Lots Of Guests

If you have lots of guests a second photographer will result in more photos for you to look back on and more candid moments of your guests.

Your Wedding Dress

Several times in your day your wedding dress will need arranging to look its best in your photos. A second photographer knows what to do, and quickly.

The Weather

Unpredictable weather means changeable light conditions. A second photographer can assist with off-camera lighting to get perfect lighting and more flattering photos.

Different Locations

Is your ceremony taking place at a different location to your reception? A second photographer means I photograph you leaving the church and they're ready for your arrival at your reception venue.

Your Venue

Booked a large venue? A second photographer lets me focus on you mingling with your guests, whilst my 'second' captures extra memories for you of your other guests.
